Packets for the 2011 LWML Sunday were recently mailed to LCMS congregations and LWML societies across the United States. The first Sunday in October is the traditional date for the celebration of LWML Sunday; however, the observance may be on any Sunday.

The LWML is honored to have Dr. Ken Klaus, Speaker Emeritus of The Lutheran Hour[®], as the author of this year's LWML Sunday materials based on the theme **Being with Jesus — Living on the Edge**. He served as a parish pastor for 28 years in South Dakota, Minnesota, Illinois, and Texas. Dr. Klaus served as Lutheran Hour Ministries (LHM) International Pastoral Advisor and became The Lutheran Hour[®] Speaker in 2002. Published works include *Stories from The Lutheran Hour – A Changeless Christ in a Changing World*, two prayer books for military personnel and their families, and daily devotions for Lutheran Hour Ministries.

The LWML Sunday packet includes an order form, a sample worship folder, sermon, children's message, along with a children's **activity** sheet that ties to the message. Also included are a banner pattern, LWML Children's Mission Adventure Poster, a new LWML items flyer, together with **additional** ideas and helps for celebrating LWML Sunday. A DVD with a short video clip by President Kay Kreklau will be sent with the order of any bulletins or the Worship Service CD.
