Reservations for the tours must be made up to **45 days** prior to the convention. If wheelchair assistance for the bus is required, 65 days advance notice is necessary. Heritage Valley Bus, Inc. of Santa Paula, California will provide transportation. Please allow for time flexibility on your return trip due to traffic delays or other unforeseen circumstances. LWML reserves the right to cancel any tour not meeting a 30-passenger minimum requirement with full payment returned. The tours offered are based on availability. You do not have to register for the convention to register for the tours. The cost of the tours does not include gratuities. ## ALL TOURS DEPART FROM THE CROWNE PLAZA MAIN ENTRANCE

### 1. Self-guided shopping and wine tasting in downtown Solvang

Thursday, June 7 – Departing at 9:00 am and returning at 5:00 pm

This Danish village is a main tourist attraction in Ventura County. The quaint shops, bakeries and Danish food will be a conversation piece for many months to come. You will enjoy walking, dining, and wine tasting to your heart's content. The approximately one and one-half hour tour bus ride takes you through the beautiful hills and mountain area of the Santa Ynez Valley on the way to Solvang. You are in the lovely green hills of Solvang and the weather may change dramatically between the ocean breezes of Ventura and the sunshine of Solvang. Layering is recommended and comfortable walking shoes are a must!



### 2. The Rose Story Farm

Friday, June 8 – Departing at 10:30 am and returning by 2:30 pm

**\$61.00 per person** – Based on 30-passenger minimum



The Rose Story Farm is a delightful garden in Carpinteria of old fashioned aromatic roses growing in the heart of Carpinteria but tucked away on a farm that will take you back in time. Enjoy the ocean scenery along the way in a specially-commissioned tour bus. The guided tour will consist of walking through the rose lined paths with the guide clipping roses for you to carry along and enjoy the aroma and beauty of the flowers. Many photo opportunities of beautiful roses exist so bring your camera. Also included is a sit-down, out-door buffet lunch and leisure conversation with one another. Take a stroll in the lovely little gift shop that features lots of items with a – you guessed it – rose theme.

### 3. Ronald Reagan Presidential Library & Museum

Friday, June 8 – Departing at 11:00 am and returning by 3:30 pm

Complimentary wheelchairs are available at the library on a first-come, first-served basis.

Ventura has a deep treasure-trove of historical places and distinct eras which mirror the diversely rich history of California itself. We invite you to follow this trail and uncover the secrets of this famous downtown: layer by layer and culture by culture. You'll see the City Hall with its marble entry and a sweeping stairway leading to the Municipal Art Gallery on the second floor. You'll also see Mission San Buenaventura, the ninth of the famous California Missions, and Figueroa Street Plaza hallmarked by Ventura's first brick building, Chinatown, a fire museum, and the Earle Stanley Gardner Building made famous by this author's Perry Mason novels. You will receive a list of special attractions with an accompanying map when you make reservations. Walking distance is one mile and may take from one to three hours depending on the number of stops you make.
