Faith Talk: Romans 6:23a says, For the wages of sin is death. What words describe what the future looks like for mankind?
Read John 3:16–17, Galatians 4:4–7, and Ephesians 2:4–9 . What is the Good News of salvation for sinners? Be specific.
See Romans 8:2 . What has Christ Jesus done for sinners?
How are we set free according to Colossians 1:21–23 ? What word-picture does Paul give to the Colossians?
to Serve! The psalmist in Psalm 118:5 says, Out of my distress I called on the Lord; the Lord answered me and set me free. Read Jesus' words in John 8:31–36. What does He teach about being "set free"?

From what has Jesus set us free? See Romans 3:22b-24, 2 Timothy 1:10, and Hebrews 2:14.
According to Romans 6:1–7 , how does the Spirit create new life in us for the sake of Jesus?
Philippians 2:1–11 gives us the perfect example of servanthood. How can Jesus' example of servanthood spur us on as we live
our lives in the Spirit?
Who was freed in Matthew 8:14–17 and from what?
What was her immediate response? Why might she respond this way?
Read Psalm 100 . Identify specific actions that accompany acts of service to the Lord
Faith Talk: Is it easier to serve or to be served? What actions might accompany service? What actions might accompany being served?

Faith Talk: Humbly share with a partner or the small group a time when, by the power of His Spirit, the Lord helped you to serve in a meaningful way as a response to God's love for you in Jesus Christ.

Faith Walk:

- 1. Read and meditate on Psalm 100. Memorize God's Word to you in this psalm.
- 2. Identify a person in your life whom you can serve, pray for guidance, and serve them with God-given gladness.
